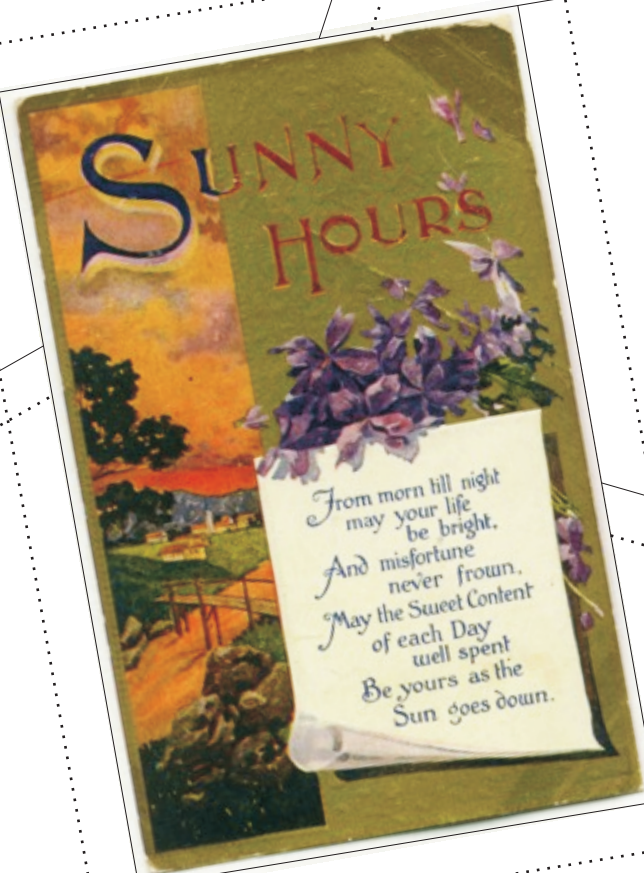

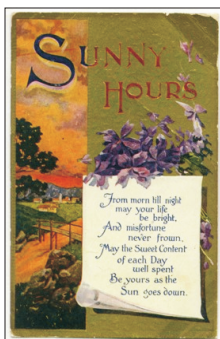

Stitch two pieces of fabric together. Treat as one piece for 2, 3, 4 and 6.
